1. Accreditation and parking cards

- Requests for additional accreditation and parking cards must be sent via the FIS Online System.

2. Race Office

3. Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art. 13)

- Booking according the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system
- The OC offers the following accommodation (all prices include full board) rates are per person, per night:

4. Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)

- Official airports: Montreal and Quebec city
- The organizing committee will arrange transportation services between the airport and the hotel. One transfer (round trip) free of charge per team.
- Information to the Shuttle service from Montreal airport:
 - Bus : Up to 40 pax = 1500 CAD
 - Mini-bus : Up to Bus 20 pax = 1000 CAD
 - Minivan : Up to Minivan 5 pax = 800 CAD
- Information to the Shuttle service from Quebec city airport:
 - Bus : Up to 40 pax = 550 CAD

- Mini-bus : Up to Bus 20 pax = 450 CAD
- Minivan : Up to Minivan 5 pax = 200 CAD

Transport application deadline: March 8, 2017

- Local shuttle service not provided since hotel is walking distance to the venue.

5. Payment (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Accommodation costs:
 - Teams can pay directly in their hotel. Payment in the hotels may be done in cash (CAD and USD only) or by credit card.
- Transportation costs:
 - All transportation costs can be paid at the race office upon arrival or upon request if applicable. Payment may be done in cash (CAD only) or by credit card.

6. Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)

- Wax cabins: available from Monday 13/03/2017
- The keys to the cabins are available at the wax village office. The deposit is 100 CAD/team. Keys return to wax village office on the day of departure.
- Canada uses 120v electricity, transformers for 220v will be available on a limited basis at each venue.

7. Regulations of radio equipment:

- Industry Canada may require on-site radio inspections in order to confirm use of approved radio frequencies. If so, Information about radios will be communicated to teams at each venue. Please bring only programmable radios if possible to ensure you will get a radio channel.

8. Regulations of Visa:

- Electronic Travel Authorization
 - New entry requirement now in effect: visa-exempt foreign nationals who fly to or transit through Canada need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA). Exceptions include U.S. citizens and travellers with a valid Canadian visa. Canadian citizens, including dual citizens, and Canadian permanent residents cannot apply for an eTA.

- Remember that citizens of some countries will need visas for visiting Canada. Please check with the Canadian embassy in your country.
