

COVID-19 Preventive Measures and Recommendations for Service Providers and Agents Attending the Audi FIS Ski World Cup 2020/21 in Sölden As of Sept. 2, 2020

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic has affected every aspect of life for both business and individuals worldwide. Thanks to the positive development of the Coronavirus infection in Austria during the summer of 2020, many COVID-19-related restrictions have been eased in many economic as well as social areas. The Austrian Ski Federation, FIS and the Sölden LOC are happy that this year's ski season again kicks off with the AUDI FIS Ski World Cup Opening in Sölden.

The **AUDI FIS Ski World Cup in Sölden from Oct. 17 & Oct. 18, 2020** will take place with enhanced safety measures. Based on the current directive by the Federal Ministry for Health and exceeding measures by Austria Ski Veranstaltungen GmbH as organizer as well as by FIS, we herewith send this measure catalogue as of Aug. 25, 2020 to the service providers and agents. Please forward this measure catalogue to all your staff members working during the world cup. By accepting the order and by registering with the accreditation system every service provider accepts the content of this measure catalogue entirely.

Basics:

- **Individual responsibility.**
- **Hygiene measures (frequent handwashing, frequent disinfection).**
- **Minimum distance of one metre everywhere.**
- **Mouth-nose protection ...**
 - on the entire event area except
 - when eating
 - at single-user workstations without contact to other people less than two metres away (mouth-nose protection must be carried along, but only used when in contact with others),
 - in closed rooms,
 - on all busses, shuttles, gondolas, and chairlifts,
 - in public areas of the quarters.

Journey to Sölden

- Do not travel to the venue with symptoms of COVID-19.
- If people close to you have been infected with COVID-19, please contact your superior and refrain from travelling to the event.
- Avoid stops when travelling to the venue.
- Avoid contact to other people – especially team members.

Accreditation

- Due to the present situation we as organisers must limit the number of accredited persons. Please accredit only persons that are really working during the world cup.

- Accreditations are possible via <https://ferevent.feratel.at/evon3/tools/loginbt/index.php> until ten days before the event.
- Access data will be provided by the LOC (Antonia Holzkecht → A.Holzkecht@soelden.com)
- Please enter all your staff's data at latest 10 days before the event and upload a picture. Accreditations can only be processed if filled in completely.
- Every staff member working during the world cup has to upload a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours via above accreditation one day before collecting the accreditation.
- Accreditations are issued only on presentation, review, and documentation of these documents; only then you can check into the booked rooms.
- Only the area manager or **one** representative of the service provider may collect all accreditations.
- Employees of the accreditation/race office wear mouth nose protection or are separated by construction (sneeze guard).

Hotel

- **Please let the LOC-Accommodation Office (incoming@oetzal.com) know how many of your staff need accommodation by Sept 20,2020.**
- The LOC has booked accommodations for service providers only (no audience/tourists).
- The staff members of the service providers are required to stay at the hotel allocated by the LOC for the time of the event.
- Wear mouth-nose protection in all public areas.
- Mouth-nose protection is obligatory in the buffet area and can be taken off at the table.
- More hygiene measures are scheduled for the buffet area.
- Keep minimum distance in all areas.

Ride from the hotel to the event venue

- Use own vehicles for transport.
- In case you do not have own vehicles, the LOC will provide shuttle busses.
- Avoid stops on the way from the hotel to the venue.
- Use only allocated and marked staff parking spot (blue parking).

Event venue

- Keep minimum distance!
- Stay only in the allocated and marked staff zones (blue zone).
- Staff zone (blue zone) is locked and only open to accredited individuals.
- Avoid direct contact to the sports teams and wear mouth-nose protection.
- Avoid contact to other staff members and members of the press.
- When in the catering area, sit together only with colleagues from your team (limit the contact to other persons).

- **Mouth-nose protection is obligatory in the catering area and all closed rooms and may only be taken off at the table.**
- A maximum of four people may ride on the same gondola; all persons must be of the same team or same working group.
- In case one of the staff members does not feel well or shows symptoms of COVID-19, please contact the LOC immediately.
- In case of symptoms, there is an isolation room close to the venue.

COVID-19 communication

- In case of symptoms inform the LOC (contact details will be announced) as well as the area manager immediately.
- LOC will activate COVID-19 chain of measures.
- All communication concerning COVID-19 must be discussed and agreed with FIS and the LOC.

Leisure activities during the stay in Sölden

- During all leisure activities always keep COVID-19 measures, such as distancing, mouth-nose protection, hygiene, and no contact, in mind.
- Limit your leisure activities to necessary shopping and errands not to be delayed.
- Spend your free time only with members of your team/group.

To minimise the risk of infection the LOC recommends:

- Small groups (max. of 20 persons, following the COVID-19-easing decree, section 10b).
- Avoid contact with sports teams.
- Limit contact to other persons.
- Avoid contact with tourists/fans.
- Frequent hand washing and disinfection.

Additional measures Sölden: Rettenbach Glacier will exclusively be used for the event from Friday Oct. 10 to Sunday Oct. 18 (no tourists, limited number of invited guests). All people present are registered. There will be no additional programme (no drawing of start numbers, no fan parade, no separate press conferences, etc.).

We appeal to EVERYONE to act RESPONSIBLE and to keep and implement all measures and recommendations! Stewards will be employed to implement and to control the compliance with the COVID-19 guidelines. For your own safety and the safety of others it is absolutely necessary to follow the instructions of the stewards.

We reserve the right to exclusion from the event and legal actions in case of non-compliance with the COVID-19 guideline.

These measures have been defined pursuant to the update decree of August 8, 2020. The organiser reserves the right for necessary changes which have to be announced immediately.
