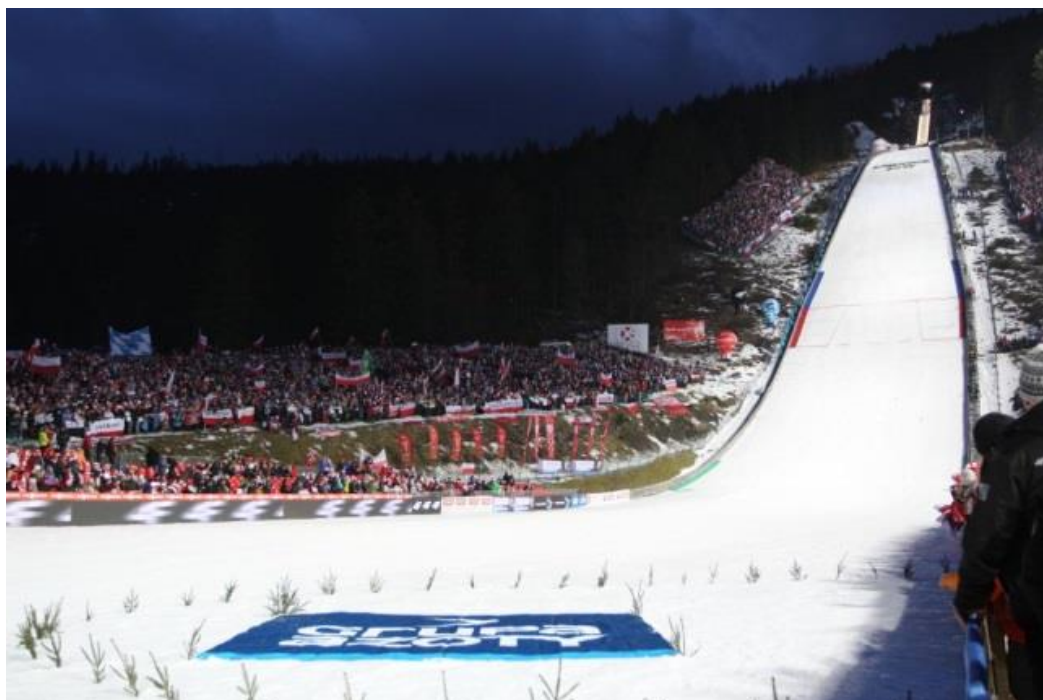
Below you will find an invitation to the FIS Continental Cup competitions that will be held in Zakopane, Poland on 13th and 14th March 2021.

ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping Continental Cup Zakopane 2021 Organizing Committee takes care of full board accommodation for all entered athletes and officials. Bookings for national teams are organized by the OC according to the team quotas and received entries.

The official COC hotel is COS OPO Zakopane, Br. Czecha 1B, Zakopane.

The price for daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is 65 Euro per person FB.

Cash and credit cards are accepted.

If there are any NSF who make their own accommodation arrangements, these are obliged to inform the LOC not later than March, 1st.

The LOC does not guarantee the availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than 15th February.

If available, alternative accommodation shall be provided.

For rooms booked and not used (free cancellation by 28th February 2021, by 12:00), full amount will be charged.
