Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski & Snowboard Associations in accordance with the rules for the FIS Snowboard Junior World Championships (Rule 9 of the rules for the FIS Snowboard Junior World Championships).

REGISTRATION

Teams registration will take place starting from Sunday, March 31st 2019 at Accreditation Office (Hotel Rogla & Planja) from 9 am till 8 pm.





ACCOMMODATION

According to the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, each participant will pay CHF 90/day directly to the Organizing Committee at the Accommodation Office. All National Teams should be aware that the amount in Euros might change according to the bank Exchange Rate on the day of payment. Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided for the nights starting from March 25th 2019 to April 5th 2019 included. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes. Reservations are only accepted with the Team Reservation Form.

Teams that will not book official accommodation will pay EUR 70/day/per athlete and will receive package including participation fee, ski ticket and lunch voucher and EUR 50/day/per staff.

AGE LIMITS

Age Limitation according ICR:

Snowboard: PAR/SBX: 1999-2003

QUOTAS: Maximum 6 per gender / per nation / per event

ENTRY CRITERIA

Entries for the FIS Junior Snowboard World Championships 2019 will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules and must be processed by the national snow sports association through the FIS Online Registration and Entry System at www.fis-ski.com

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.





ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Snowboard Club Rogla Planja, Snowboard Team Slovenia, Unitur d.o.o, sponsors, suppliers, their agents and FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event. All athletes must have previously signed the "FIS Athletes Declaration" form in order to register.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Snowboard Club Rogla Planja, Snowboard Team Slovenia, Unitur d.o.o, FIS, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employers and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

How to get to Rogla – Zreško Pohorje

a) By airplane: There is an international airport in Maribor which is mostly used for private flights, charter and cargo flights. Other international airports are located in Ljubljana (Slovenia) and Graz (Austria), approximately 120 km away from Rogla,

b) By car From Italy, crossing the border at Ferneti, take the highway to Ljubljana, proceed towards Maribor (exit Slovenske Konjice). From Austria through the border crossing Šentilj, pass Maribor and take the highway towards Ljubljana (exit Slovenske Konjice). From Austria through border crossing Celovec (Klagenfurt), pass Slovenj Gradec, proceed towards Celje and then take the highway towards Maribor (exit Slovenske Konjice).
