COVID-19 warning

The use of face mask is mandatory in the hotel, race office. TCM is required just for one person per nation with keeping the 2 m distance to each other and with wearing the face mask. Look for details in COVID-19 protocol for FIS Events below.

GENERAL RULES

The Competition is organized according to the ICR and FIS MASTERS rules
The organizers point out of the compulsory insurance and any responsibility for injured competitors, officials or spectators must be declined. FIS approved crash helmet is mandatory !
All protests and appeals as per FIS rules.

ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS

Participation is limited to Male and Female skier member of FIS, born 1990 and older, who are members of their NSA. Each NSA bears the responsibility that their entered competitors have signed FIS Athletes' Declaration. Athletes and coaches are responsible for their own insurance. It's necessary to have an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code. Competitor competes on their own responsibility. The organization declines any responsibility in case of accidents or other liability (possible COVID illness) claims.

LIABILITY

The organizers point out the compulsory insurance, they will not take any liability for participants, officials and spectators. If case of COVID-19 measures change at the »last minute«, the organizer allows himself to cancel the competition without liability and reimburses of the expenses.

If the number of participants is insufficient, the organizer allows himself to cancel the competition (last day for canceling is February, 1th, 2021)

ENTRY FEE 20,00 €

Lift ticket price: for hotel CerknO guests is already included in hotel's price.
If the Ski resort is closed at the time Slovenian masters 33 eur / per day, with SSV card 25 eur.
If the Ski resort is open SSV is valid, price for racers without SSV is 10% discount

ACCOMMODATION

The Hotel CerknO will be open just for us, our recommendation is to take half board in the hotel, because bars and restaurants in Slovenia are closed. It's only possible to order take away in some restaurants.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR FIS EVENTS:

*This Protocol applies to FIS competitions including MAS.

* It supplements and does not replace the national and regional regulations for:

PREVENTION

Competition can be safe with responsible behavior of all presents. Health takes the highest priority; a high level of solidarity and individual responsibility is required. **Person with COVID-19 symptoms must refrain from the event!**

The OC must be informed as soon as possible if COVID-19 is diagnosed after the event (within 14 days).

INFORMATION DURING THE COMPETITION

For all registered competitors and team leader (who send us phone number) will be open the Whatsapp group FMCCERKNO21, where will be all kind race information up to date.

BORDER CROSSING – ENTER TO SLOVENIA

Certain restrictions apply for crossing the state borders and these depend on the country from which you are arriving in Slovenia.

Passengers traveling to Republic of Slovenia from EU / EEA member state (regardless of their citizenship)

Countries **with an unstable epidemiological situation** or administrative divisions of countries are included on the red list.

People entering the Republic of Slovenia from these countries (app. Austria, Italy, Croatia, Czechia, Germany, Slovakia, Switzerland, France....) shall, due to potential infection with SARS-CoV-2 virus, be required to **remain in quarantine for a period of ten (10) days**.

Any person who presents a **negative test for SARS-CoV-2 upon entry into Slovenia will not need to quarantine**. The test must be performed by the PCR method in an EU Member State or Schengen Area country, or by organisations or individuals in third countries recognised as relevant by the Institute of Microbiology and Immunology and the National Laboratory of Health, Environment and Food (NLZOH), and published on the NLZOH website, and **must not be older than 48 hours after taking the swab**. The testing may also be performed by a **rapid antigen test** in an EU Member State or Schengen Area country, **and may not be older than 24 hours after taking the swab**.

TCM; START NUMBERS

TCM is recommended just for one person per nation. Wearing a face mask and keeping the social distance is mandatory.

Wearing a face mask and keep the distance while you pick up the BIB in race office or finish area. Return the BIB in finish area immediately after you finish the race. BIB's will be disinfected after each competitor.

COMPETITION COURSE

Will have access with an individual entrance to the track. Entry to the course inspection or start area will be allowed wearing the BIB and with face mask on. No spectators allowed.

START AREA

A departure area large enough to guarantee the required distance must be defined.

Everyone allowed in the start area must wear the mask.

Athletes can only remove the mask within the starting area 5 minutes before their start.

FINISH AREA

Everyone allowed in the arrival area must wear the mask. Athletes must wear mask if they stay longer than necessary.

The athletes must leave the common area as soon as possible.

The athletes must leave the BIB in finish area in a designated place, without contact with any other persons.

No scoreboard of results is allowed, results will be on line.

It's forbidden to organize buffet.

AWARD CEREMONIES

Will be organised in finish area without public, just for medal winners. Face mask must be worn during the award ceremony for all. The award ceremonies will take place without personal contacts.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

All participants are responsible for their own protective equipment (masks, disinfectans) and will bring these with them themselves.

ACCOMMODATION

Hotel Cerkno will be open just for FMC competitors. Behavior in the hotel refers to the valid recommendations of the NIJZ (mask, distancing...)
