1. LOCATION OF THE EVENT

SKI Flying Hill HS 240

2. REGISTRATION

Please send preliminary entries until February 10th, 2022 and official entries until March 16th, 2022.

3. PARTICIPATION

The number of participants at all World Cup competitions is defined according to the FIS rules.

4. INSURANCE

All athletes have to be insured through their national ski federations.

The organizer is not responsible for any personal injuries or damage to property that might occur.

All participants must have an adequate insurance coverage against accidents, illness, and civil liability.

5. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control might occur during the event. Doping control may be carried out at any FIS competition according to FIS Anti-Doping Rules.

6. COMPETITION RULES

The competitions will be held in compliance with FIS Competition rules as in effect.

7. TRANSPORT SERVICE

Free transport service is offered during your stay in Planica, including pick-up and delivery

service from Ljubljana airport (please enter your travelling data into the accommodation form).

8. ACCOMMODATION

The Organizers 'payment of costs for the athletes will be according to FIS Rules. In case of less competitors and officials than entered, no-show has to be paid.

Please send preliminary entries until February 10th, 2022.

9. PRIZE MONEY

The prize money is paid out according to FIS rules and is subject to the athlete's participation at official FIS events.

The winners press conferences, public starting bibs` handout and the opening ceremony are official FIS events. The organizing committee expressly reserves the right to reduce the amount of the prize money in case an athlete fails to fulfill these obligations.

10. THE PLANICA 7

The Organizing committee Planica will once again present a prize for the athlete who gathers the most points during the 7 official rounds of the event. The winner will receive 20.000 SFR.

- 1. OC Planica will in accordance with FIS present a special Prize money award in the 2022 event, that will take part from March 24th 27th.
- 2.The winner of the Planica 7 prize will receive 20.000 SFR paid under the same terms as the prize money regulated in the FIS and ICR rules.
- 3. The winner will be the athlete that has earned / gained the most points at the end of the event

- 4. The sum of the points is calculated from the following rounds:
- Qualification round March 24th 2022
- First round March 25th 2022
- Final round March 25th 2022
- First round March 26th 2022 (the points of a single athlete participating in the team)
- Final round March 26th 2022 (the points of a single athlete participating in the team)
- First round March 27th 2022
- Final round March 27th 2022
- 5. At least 4 rounds with official results must be held in order for the prize to be paid.
- 6. Each athlete in the lead after the rounds listed will be awarded after the daily competition with an additional gift prize.
- 7. The winner will be officially announced on March 27th 2022 at the winners ceremony after the daily competition ceremony.
- 8. The winner must be available for one official photo right after the ceremony.

11. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

a) GENERAL INFORMATION

An end to most Covid-19 restrictions in Slovenia.

As of 21 February 2022, the RVT (recovered/vaccinated/tested) rule will no longer be required except in healthcare and social care institutions and in prisons.

Measures that are still in place to contain the spread of COVID-19 infections:

- · hygienic measures: sanitizing, keeping social distance
- · wear a face mask in closed public spaces and on public transport,
- · wearing face mask in school.

b) BORDER CROSSING

As of 19 February 2022, restrictions due to Covid-19 no longer apply when entering Slovenia. This means that the RVT (recovered/vaccinated/tested) condition no longer has to be met at the border and travellers will no longer be ordered to quarantine at home.

c) LOC TESTING PROTOCOL FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

All athletes and members of the team can participate at the event if they have a certificate of a negative COVID-19 PCR test, which is not older than 48 hours.

HOTEL KOMPAS

It will be a "snowflake" hotel, only for the teams, jury members, FIS representatives and competition management. No other guests.

d) ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will only be activated if all the requested information is collected:

- Negative PCR test made upon arrival.
- The use of FIS passport with necessary data accordingly:
- a) To upload negative COVID-19 test result not older than 48h.
- b) To answer Pre-Event Questionnaire.

Only one person for each team will be allowed to pick up all the accreditations in the accreditation office in Hotel Kompas

The LOC will withdraw the accreditation at any time:

- if person is tested positive for COVID-19;
- if regulations and guidelines are not respected.

e) TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING

Will be held according to the official program in Hotel Kompas.

One member per team can be present in person.

f) VENUE

A SNOWFLAKE - green area will be created for the following:

- Athletes, Team members
- Jury members
- FIS members
- Service company members

All persons with the access to the green area will need to have a negative COVID-19 PCR test not older than 48 hours.

Green area consists of:

- Athletes' village
- Chair Lift
- Warm-up room at the start. Limited number of athletes. Beverages and snacks will be available. Face mask is obligatory.
- Judges' tower. (judges and competition management room only)
- Coaches' stand. Coaches must wear mask and keep social distance at all time.
- Exit Gate. Athletes must wear mask when entering the area.
- Equipment control at exit gate. Located in a container, the same position as in previous years.
- Mixed Zone (corridor for athletes)

To access green area facilities special corridors will be arranged to avoid crossing with others. It will be properly marked with directional signs.

g) GREEN AREA/SNOWFLAKE RULES:

- Wearing face mask indoors and outdoors at all time.
- No need only: 1. during the warmup (keep the obligatory social distance 2 m); 2. right before the start; 3. when eating or drinking.
- In any common space it is not allowed to leave the masks on tables or on any other surfaces. It is recommended to put them in a proper shell or throw them in a bin in case of replacement.
- Keep social distance: at least 2 m.
- Regular hand washing and disinfection: regularly and properly wash hands with soap and water. If water and soap are not available, use a hand sanitizer to disinfect your hands.
- Transport: we encourage competition teams to use their own transportation means. Parking lots for those vehicles will be assured in green areas in front of official hotel and at competition venue in

Planica.

i) INFORMATION IN CASE OF THE SYMPTOMS

Any problem or discomfort must be immediately reported to the COVID-19 Event Coordinator appointed by the LOC.

Any person suspected of having COVID-19 will be examined by the LOC's Head of Medical Service who will be present at the venue during the whole event, immediately tested and isolated in dedicated room to wait for the test results. Tracing and quarantine protocols will be immediately activated.

If a person tests positive to COVID-19, he/she will be quarantined and processed according to the rules of National Health Authorities before returning to their respective country, if hospitalization is not required.

The external communication regarding COVID-19 situation needs to be discussed and approved by FIS Officials and OC Planica representatives.
