Over the years, we have enjoyed many exceptional ski flying jumps at this hill. This is top sport, combined with entertainment - at an extremely high level. We are extra pleased that the world record in ski flying now belongs to Vikersund and Modum. It happened in 2017, when Stefan Kraft from Austria reached 253,5 meters.

Vikersund jumping center has in recent years developed into a modern year-round facility, where both residents and tourists get experiences and challenges. The accommodation for teams will be in a hotel approximately 40 minutes by bus from the venues in Vikersund. The OC has a good cooperation with the hotels and can promise you an adequate accommodation especially adjusted to the needs of the athletes and team.

There will be an information desk at the hotel, attended by qualified and service minded staff skilled in languages.

Rooms for physical therapist, team meetings etc. can be booked directly from the reception and should be paid directly to the hotel together with other extras, such as extra drinks etc.

The payment of costs for athletes will be according to the FIS rules. In case of arrival off fewer competitors and officials that accommodation reservations made, no-show has to be paid.

Booking of accommodation is according to the FIS rules/FIS online registration system.

Transportation

Transportation from Holmenkollen will be arranged. Shuttle service -Hotel – Venue OC will provide regular shuttle service free of charge between the team hotels/venue. Look for the bus schedule at the Service Desk in the hotel. There will be a representative from OC Transport Service at the team hotel.

Parking

There is only a limited number of parking places in the venue. Parking passes are required. The OC therefore strongly recommend using the shuttle service.

Insurance

The organiser is responsible for the insurance according to the FIS rules (212.2).

Reimbursement

The organiser will reimburse the athletes and their leaders/trainers for accommodation expenses according to the FIS rules. Athletes and leaders beyond the quota must pay directly to the hotel.

Regulations of radio equipment

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Norway is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radiotransmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications. For further information and application form ('Application for temporary use of radios in Norway') see: www.npt.no. The application must be forwarded before 1 February 2022.

Team Attaches

Each nation might have their own attaché during the World Championships to support the teams with their arrivals and departures and to provide administrative and linguistic support. Each Team Manager will determine the specific responsibilities and duties of the attaches in accordance to the duties mentioned above. Accreditation

The Main Accreditation Centre will be located at Sport Club's house in Vikersund 3 km from the venue. There will also be Sub Accreditation Centre at the venue.

Rules

The competitions will be held in compliance with the FIS rules.

Participation

The number of participants in the Ski Flying World Championships is defined according to the FIS rules.

1. Payment

Travel Expenses will be transferred to each Team's bank account. Please note that it will not be possible to receive cash. Prize Money will be paid by bank transfer to the Athletes after the FIS World championship. In addition to the prize money regulated by the FIS World Championship rules.

2. Income tax information for prize money

- The current Norwegian tax rate for non resident athletes is 15%. Due to a special tax convention between Norway and USA,

income tax will not be deducted by the OC for income less than USD10000 – “the income shall be taxable only in the State of which the sportsman is a resident”.

- Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Norwegian Foreign Artist Taxation Act, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

3. Waxing facilities – location

- Vikersund: Ski wax cabins will be located at the team area at the hill. There will be no ski-waxing rooms available at the hotels.

4. Visa Regulations

- Remember that citizens of some countries will need visa for visiting Norway. Please check with your embassy if you need a visa to enter into Norway. For an official letter of Invitation, please send a request to the OC Secretariat: post@vikersund.no

Time-limits for Entry

Preliminary team entry: 10 December 2021

Provisional team selection: 18 of February 2022

Final team selection: 7 March 2022
