**Special procedures:** If total registration is 135 competitors or less, then one set of judges will be used - The HJ will be on Site and 5 Remote Judges. If registration is significantly greater than 135 two sets of judges will be used - 2 Head Judges on site and 2 groups of 5 judges remote.

Competitors will be divided into two seeded groups by their FIS Points. The jury will determine the break point and this will be announced at the first TCM.

Event Process for large field:

Seeded Group 1 - Women and Men - will train and compete together. One Judges Panel will judge the Women and one Judges Panel will judge the Men. Competitors will alternate Woman then Man in approximately a 45 second interval. Seeded Group 1 will have an equal amount of Women and Men. Seeded Group 2 - Women and Men - will have a separate training session after Seed Group 1 competes. Seeded Group 2 will follow the same procedures as seeded Group 1. If and when one gender is finished, then the competition will proceed with the other remaining gender in a normal event interval.
