The 2023 Denver Sports Lab FIS Masters Cup and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters Western Regional Championships will be held in the Rocky Division at Beaver Creek, CO. The event will include 2SG, 2 one-run GS and SL races all held on the Bear Trap trail accessed by the Centennial Express Lift in the base area.

North American Entries:

USA and CAN racers can register online for training and races starting December 5 at: masters.adminskiracing.com, select "National" as your race series if your division is not listed, enter your credit card information, and sign up online. Races are listed in the Rocky Mountain Masters race series.

Credit cards will be charged on February 1st.

International Entries:

International racers are required to have FIS entry sent from the National Ski Federation to: fismasters@usalpinemasters.org International racers with USA or CAN credit card should also create an account at masters.adminskiracing.com, select "National" as your race series, enter your credit card information, and sign up online. Races are listed in the Rocky Mountain Masters race series. Credit cards will be charged on February 1st. **The online payment processor cannot process credit cards from outside North America. Payments for international entries can be made onsite through the Beaver Creek race department.**

RACE FEES (does not include lift ticket - see lift prices below)

\$25 (€ 20) per race (5 races total \$125 for all races).

LIFT TICKETS

- Beaver Creek is on the Epic Pass.
- For non-passholders, lift tickets are available for both training and race days February 2-5. You can purchase the discounted tickets at Race City, the building next to the bottom of the Centennial lift and by the bag storage.

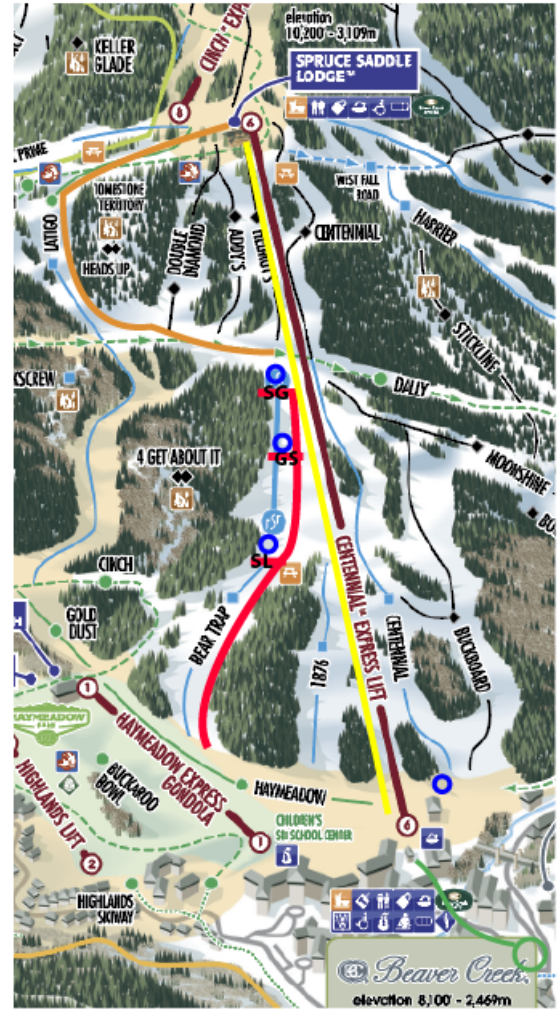

Course access may be via Latigo or Centennial - please check the the TCM updates if a specific trail is groomed or recommended for racers.



ELIGIBILITY

- FIS Masters Cup races are open to men and women age 30 and older as of December 31, 2022 with a current FIS Masters license and an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code. US competitors must have a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership as well as a current FIS masters license and an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code.
- US masters under age 30 with a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership may compete in the US Western Region Championship but are not eligible for FIS Masters awards.
- US masters and Canadians are eligible for Western Regional Championship Awards.
- USA competitors can purchase a FIS Masters License when renewing your U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership at my.uskisansnowboard.org. If you have already renewed you can [add a FIS Masters License](#).

If you have FIS Masters points, you MUST renew by January 28th to be on the current points list! If you renew after that date, you will not have points for start list seeding and will be placed in the unseeded group at the end of your age class.



HELMETS

It is REQUIRED that Masters use helmets that meet the FIS standards for FIS Masters GS and SG competitions which have a stamp affixed by the manufacturer that states "Conforms to FIS Specification RH 2013".

RACER CHECK-IN/HEADQUARTERS

All race documents (start lists, referee reports, results, etc) will be delivered via WhatsApp and nightly in an email. Check-in and bib pickup:

- For morning pickup Feb 2-5 go to Race City lookers right of the Centennial Lift from 7:45-8:15 AM. You will purchase lift tickets at this time also.
- Evening pickup is also available 4-6PM on February 2nd before the first TCM meeting at the Comfort Inn.

TEAM CAPTAINS MEETINGS (TCM)

Team Captains Meetings will be held at 6PM on Thursday after check-in at the Comfort Inn meeting room and the EagleVail Pavillion Friday and Saturday before the awards ceremony. All TCMs will be available virtually, via web or phone, and in person. The virtual link and phone number will be updated closer to the event and distributed to all registered participants via email.

BAG STORAGE

The best places to keep gear during the race day will be at the start or in the fenced area above the building next to the Centennial lift. Lodge access should be greater than last season but will be limited. No bags are allowed to be stored in the lodge. Most parking lots require a shuttle to the base area.

SPECTATORS

For spectators on foot, you can take the Haymeadow Express Gondola (no lift ticket required) from the base area, cross the Haymeadow trail, and walk down along the trees to the bear trap race finish. Please look uphill while crossing the trail and stay outside the finish fencing for your safety. Can be done in snow boots but yak-tracks or micro-spikes are helpful if you have them.
