SNOWFEST*

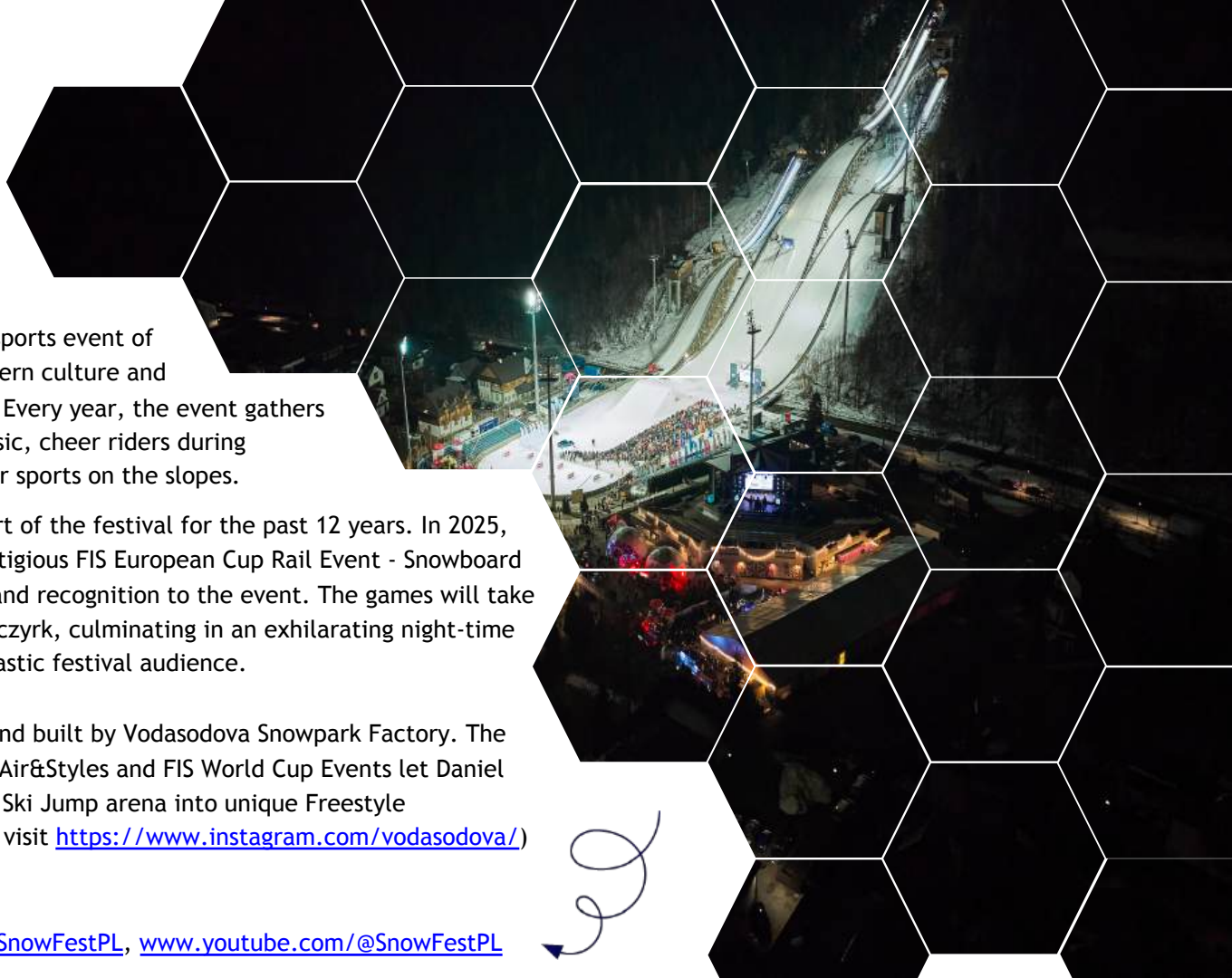

REGISTRATION

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. To entry the competition, please complete 2 obligatory steps:

- * Step 1: Please submit your entry through a SnowFest Games [Registration Form](#) no later than **February 15th, 2025**.
- * Step 2: Please enter through the FIS Online Entry tool in the member section of the FIS website no later than **February 25th, 2025**.

For the 2024-2025 season, no minimum points are required to enter European Cups Rail. Please note that SnowFest Games provides a very high level street set up. Please only enter athletes capable of riding such structures.

All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Race Office for check-in before proceeding to the competition venue.



ENTRY FEES

We do not collect any entry fee from the teams and athletes. Your games participation as well as access to festival facilities is free of charge.

Each Athlete or team member gets two, 2-day passes for the purpose of joining the music festival, please read 'Rules Of The Festival' using following:

TRANSPORTATION

Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The most convenient airport for 'airport-Szczyrk-airport' route using public transport is Katowice-Pyrzowice (KTW), 118 km away.

Other international airports nearby are Kraków (KRK) 111 km, Ostrava in Czechia (OSR) 110 km.

BIBS & HELMETS

A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib.
